Recyclable Items

Republic Service's **All-In-One Recycling™** program means all recyclables are placed into one container with no sorting. All recyclables must be clean, empty, dry and not bagged. The following items should be placed in your recycling container:



Paper

- Paper (staples okay)
- Newspaper
- Envelopes
- Junk mail
- Phone books
- Brochures
- Magazines



Cardboard

- Ream wrappers
- File folders
- Poster board
- Frozen food boxes
- Cardboard boxes
- Milk cartons



Plastic

- Water bottles
- Take-out containers
- Soda bottles
- Bagged film plastics



Metal

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Food cans
- Scrap metal



Glass

- Colored glass
- Jars

Non-recyclable Items

- Plastic grocery bags or trash bags
- Waxed cartons
- Batteries
- Styrofoam, (food containers, cups and packing peanuts)
- Foil
- Pill bottles
- Plastic or metal clothes hangers
- Light bulbs
- Frozen food bags and chip bags
- Hazardous or toxic product containers (paint cans or lighter fluid containers)

- Food and wet waste
- Food-contaminated paper plates and napkins
- Appliances and electronics
- Bubble wrap
- Garden hoses
- Rubber balls and sports equipment
- Tires
- Wood
- Yard waste
