AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE EVART CITY ZONING ORDINANCE

THE CITY OF EVART, OSCEOLA COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS

SECTION 1: PURPOSE AND INTENT

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend the Evert City Zoning Ordinance, as it relates to Medical Marihuana.

Section 4.2.8 (b) of the Evert City Zoning Ordinance, is amended to read as follows:

**4.2.8 Medical Marihuana**

**(b) As regulated by the Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing Act, MCL 333.27101 et seq and the Marihuana Tracking Act, MCL 333.27901 et seq., following medical marihuana facilities are permitted through special use permit in the City of Evert:**

- 1. Medical Marihuana safety compliance facilities;**
- 2. Medical Marihuana processor facilities;**
- 3. Medical Marihuana secure transporters;**
- 4. Medical Marihuana grower facilities; and**
- 5. Medical Marihuana provisioning centers**

**All Medical Marihuana grower facilities must be located within the I-2: General Industrial District. All other Medical Marihuana facilities must be located within the I-2: General Industrial District, or the C-2: General Business District, and must be in compliance with City of Evert Ordinance No. 2018-1, entitled “An Ordinance to Authorize and Regulate the Establishment of Medical Marihuana Facilities.” Please refer to Evert Ordinance No 2018-1 for specific permitting, building and operational standards.**


SECTION 2: CONFLICTING ORDINANCES


