270.01 CONTINUATION OF EXISTING BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

All boards and commissions existing at the time of the adoption of these Codified Ordinances shall be continued and the members serving thereon shall remain in office for the duration of the term for which they were appointed.

270.02 VACANCIES.

Unless otherwise provided, any vacancy occurring in the membership of any board or commission shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term in the manner provided for original appointment.

270.03 REMOVAL.

The appointing authority may remove any member of any board or commission for cause, but any member shall be entitled to a public hearing on such removal, on written demand filed with the appointing authority within ten days after notice of removal has been given to such member.

270.04 COMPENSATION.

Unless otherwise provided, all members of boards and commission shall serve without compensation as members thereof.

270.05 INDEMNIFICATION OF MEMBERS.

The City of Ewart shall indemnify any member of a board or commission who was or is a party or is threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding by reason of the fact that he or she is or was a member of a board or commission serving at the request of or through the appointment of the City of Ewart, against expenses (including attorney's fees), judgments, fines and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by him or her in connection with such action, suit or proceeding.
