Subject: Michigan Rural Community Demolition Grant

The deadline for the demolition grant is February 14, 2019, we have contacted several land owners refrence their blighted properties and so far, we only have two confirmed properties: William Jennings' property 843 W. Jefferson St and Greg Schankin's property 828 N. Cedar St., both property owners gave verbal confirmation of agreeing to 5-year lien on their property if structures were demolished by the grant. I spoke with Jordan Dewitt the current owner of 402 W. 10th St. (see picture).



Jordan agreed to sell the property to the city for \$1,500.00 plus current taxes \$337.97 and delinquent taxes \$896.57 totaling \$2,734.54. After obtaining the property the city could then move forward with the demo grant for the house. I spoke with Jim and he stated he could do the title work tomorrow. Please review for discussion.
