Re: 110 East Eighth Street Sewer Credit

On March 25, 2019, Mr. Ronald Woycehoski was contacted to inform him the March 2019 meter read for 110 East Eighth Street was extremely high. After checking the house, he noticed water covering the floor in the kitchen. Mr. Woycehoski stated a pipe had burst under the kitchen sink. He inquired about a sewer credit for this leak and stated, even though 110 East Eighth Street is on the "Water Run" list he was not running the water. As the house has been vacant since the end of January, there should have been no usage at all for this location. The total usage recorded for March 2019 was 256,067 gallons.

As a past practice, the city manager has only granted credits in the amount of \$100 or less. Therefore, I would like to request council permission to apply a sewer credit to Mr. Woycehoski's March 2019 bill in the amount of \$1,828.34 because the water did not enter our sewer system. Please see calculations below.

March Credit Calculations

256,067 (February read) – 0 (Usage that should have occurred) = 256,067  
256,067 / 1,000 = 256.07  
256.07 x 7.14 = \$1828.34 Sewer Credit
