North Oak Street Update...

The lead service line replacement project is currently underway. A portion of this project will utilize funds the city received from Great Lakes & Energy (EGLE) for the removal and replacement of lead or galvanized service pipes between the property line and the home.

The first section of this project will begin with the 100 block of North Oak Street and should be complete by September 30, 2019. We understand this street is quite busy, so we appreciate your patience while Gerber Construction is working. There will be a detour on North Cherry Street.
